CYC/CYSN Worker provides services directly to children and youth, who have been removed or are at risk of being removed from their families; or children who have a mental health disorder or who are at risk of developing a mental health disorder. Services are also provided to children and youth who have developmental disabilities. Referrals will be initiated by the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD). The service will provide short term, intensive and outcome-focused interventions/services that promote growth and improve family functioning.
