### JOB SUMMARY

Community Action Plan for Children (CAPC) Worker supports children ages 0-6 and their families. The CAPC worker responds to inquiries from parents, professionals and the general public regarding, but not limited to, pregnancy and postpartum supports, breastfeeding supports, postpartum depression and anxiety, early literacy, FASD, healthy living and parenting skills. Service delivery will occur both on site and through outreach. Worker will deliver prevention based groups that serve to enhance the outcomes of children and families in the communities of Vanderhoof and Fraser Lake.

CYC Worker provides services directly to children and youth, who have been removed or are at risk of being removed from their families; or children who have a mental health disorder or who are at risk of developing a mental health disorder.

The service will provide short term, intensive and outcome-focused interventions/services that promote growth and improve family functioning. This program will focus on developing the personal, social and familial competencies in children and youth. Worker will deliver services in the communities of Vanderhoof and Fraser Lake. Travel required for this position.
