Family Preservation Clinician

JOB SUMMARY

The Family Preservation clinician provides short term, intensive, in-home counselling and skill based work to assist families in reducing risk factors and threats to family and individual well-being. When appropriate, service will also be delivered as group work.

This program provides services for Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) referred families who have been identified as medium to high risk of out of home placement for their child/children. Typically, referred families have come to the attention of MCFD as a result of child protection issues.
