The Early Years Outreach Worker supports children and their families in a variety of ways. The position responds to inquiries from parents, professionals and the general public regarding, but not limited to, pregnancy and postpartum supports, breastfeeding supports, postpartum depression and anxiety, early literacy, FASD, healthy living and parenting skill. It also requires work with children who may be experiencing or at risk of experiencing mental health concerns and the risk of removal. Service delivery will occur both on site and through outreach programs. Worker will deliver prevention based groups that serve to enhance the outcomes of children and families in the communities of Vanderhoof and Fraser Lake.

The service will provide outcome-focused interventions/services that promote healthy growth and development will improve family functioning. This program will focus on developing the personal, social and familial competencies in children. Travel required for this position.
