Child & Youth Care Worker

JOB SUMMARY

This is a combined position for a qualified individual to undertake Child & Youth Care (CYC) and Child & Youth with Special Needs (CYSN) work providing services directly to children and youth, who have been removed or are at risk of being removed from their families; or children who have a mental health disorder or who are at risk of developing a mental health disorder. Services are also provided to children and youth who have developmental disabilities.

NOTE: Referrals will be initiated by the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) for Child & Youth with Special Needs (CYSN).

NOTE: Referrals for Child & Youth Care will be initiated by schools, parent, individual client him/herself, MCFD, or other community agency (CYC).

The CYC/CYSN Worker will provide short term, intensive and outcome-focused interventions/services that promote growth and improve family functioning. This includes a focus on developing the personal, social and familial competencies in children and youth.
