JOB SUMMARY

In this **Police-Based Victim Services role, the worker is located in the RCMP detachment.** The Worker provides victims and witnesses of crime and trauma with information, practical assistance and emotional support needed to participate in the justice system. Service is delivered on a flexible basis to respond to urgent situations and provide timely follow up and support in the following:

- Critical incidence response in coordination with police
- Criminal Justice System information and support to client (VOCA, Crown, Corrections and more)
- Safety Planning information and referrals as per assessment of client needs
- Practical and Emotional Support for client to assist with impacts of crime and trauma
- Information and Referrals to client about Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General supports and other community/regional agency supports.
